European Jewish Leaders Remain Defiant

We will not, as some others have done, question Benjamin Netanyahu's sincerity when he told a beleaguered European Jewry that "the State of Israel is your home." We'll give him the benefit of the doubt that he was not engaged in crude electioneering, playing to a domestic audience in an election campaign that polls said was sputtering. The Israeli prime minister was, after all, not saving anything that hasn't been said before. In 2004 Ariel Sharon told French Jewry "to move to Israel as soon as possible." And David Ben Gurion continually belittled Diaspora Jewry living а life of Jewish "Godlessness". We are pleased, however, that European Jewish leaders rejected Netanyahu's preaching of despair as a motive for making aliya and by implictly suggesting that Jewish life in the Diaspora is less authentic than it is in Israel. "The Israel government" said Menachim Margolin, the director of the European Jewish Association, "must stop this Pavlovian response every time there is an attack against Jews in Europe." "Terror", added Denmark's chief rabbi, Jair Melchior, "is not a reason to move to Israel".

No one will deny European Jewish life and lives are facing uncertain future. an Community Centres and synagogues should not have to be turned into garrisons. And the resurgence of anti-Semitism has led to unprecedented numbers of especially French Jews, "not waiting around here to die". But half a million Jews in France, 30,000 in the Netherlands, 6400 in Denmark and thousands elsewhere are not going anywhere, even if they have to lower their Jewish profile. Many will stay put for practical reasons. There

are family ties to consider. There would be a new language to learn and new jobs to be found. Children would have to adjust to a strange academic environment. But even if these obstacles were not insurmountable most Jews would still tell Netanyahu to stop offering them unsolicited advice. Despite the current unrest, Jews take comfort in the fact that they face no religious persecution or social rejection. Europe is not about to spawn another monster. "Italy," says Alberto Saravelle, a lawyer in Milan, "is my home...My father and uncle were forced to leave this country in 1939 and I don't want to do that".

Ideally Jews and Muslims would be building bridges between their communities. But the streets of Bury Park in London, Kuregen Molenbeek in and Brussels. Kolenkit in Amsterdam Trappes in Paris have no interest in dialogue. Jews will inevitably again be targeted by home grown terrorists confident they can be hidden in their "no-go" areas. Governments can order guards at synagogues, day schools and community centres. A policeman can't accompany every Jew wearing a kippa on his way to shul.

And yet European Jewry has no intention of submitting supineto Islamist fanatics. Benjamin Netanyahu's comments, whatever their motive, denigrate the achievements of the Jews of the golah during their centuries of dispersion. They decry the whole of Jewish history which created the Talmud, the Golden Age in Moslem Spain, the Hassidic Movement, the Yiddish language, and other products of a living, dynamic people. "We are staying in Denmark", spokesman Jeppe Juhl, defiantly. So, too, are most of his fellow Jews.

Boris Nemtsov -Jewish By Birth Only

Boris Nemtsov, the murdered Russian politician, was the son of a Jewish mother. But like many other Russian politicians of Jewish descent, Nemtsov spared no effort to hide his Jewish background. His rejection of Judaism occurred early in his career. When the Russian Jewish Congress was created in 1996 Nemtsov was asked to join. He refused, partly on the advice of his mother who was reluctant to admit that she was Jewish. He then converted to Russian Orthodoxy as a further means of distancing himself from his Jewish roots. And vet when Nemtsov was asked after his conversion why he was involved in the politics of dissent, he answered: "We are Jewish, we have to fight for truth and freedom".

Meanwhile the tension between Russian Jews and the Orthodox Church is reaching new heights. The church continues to approach Jews in government positions telling them that conversion will ensure their safety. Nemtsov's murder shows that conversion is anything but a guarantee of longevity.

Muslim Holidays Join Rosh Hashanah


Starting next fall, New York City's biggest public school system will give its 1.1 million students the day off for the Muslim holidays of Eid-ak-Fitr and Eid al-Adha. Some 12% the student body is Muslim. Former mayor Michael Bloomberg opposed the closing of schools but current mayor Bill de Blasio had made it one of his campaign promises, trying to reach out to the estimated 600,000 Muslims living in New York. "This is a common sense change, and one that recognizes our growing Muslim community" said Mayor de Blasio.

Frederick County in Maryland and Waterbury, Connecticut were previously the only boards in the nation to close on Muslim holidays. The New York Times called it a "watershed moment". for a group that has endured so much since Sept. 11. Others, however, ask 2% of the population deserves special treatment.

Not Specifically A Jewish Program...But

The funding bill for the Department of Homeland Security has passed Congress. The bill allots \$13 million for security upgrades at religious and nonprofit institutions. And once again Jewish groups will be the big winners.

Since 2005, the Nonprofit Security Grant Program has provided \$118 million to organizations to improve security. From 2007 to 2010 some 73.7% of that money went to Jewish organizations. In 2011 81% of the money went to Jewish groups. There is every reason to believe that the bulk of this year's funding will also be ear-

of worship, schools and

community centers.

damental principle of separating church and state in return for something that has very little impact on the community", says Rabbi David Saperstein, director of the Reform movement's Religious Action Center. Saperstein's view undoubtedly influenced by the fact that some twothirds of the grants are going to Orthodox institutions, even though only about one out of every ten American Jew is Orthodox. "There will always be far more communal institutions that want or need security enhancements than government funds available", added Tod Gutnick of the Anti-"This Defamation League. inevitably leads to divisive intra-communal competifor these scarce resources, and a politicization of the grant-making process".

Still, new lights and state of the art surveillance systems at synagogues are evidence that the grants are being put to good use.

ECONOMIC TIES WITH TURKEY GROW

POLITICAL DISPUTES BETWEEN ISRAEL AND TURKEY NOT AFFECTING TRADE

Israelis buying a Japanese car in Tel Aviv might be surprised to learn that the car was actually built in Turkey. Tourists buying dried figs in Israel's Machane Yehuda market probably also don't know that the figs are also import-

These are just two of the examples of the burgeoning trade between

Israel and Turkey, trade that has more than doubled in the past five years, according to the Turkish Statistics Institute, and confirmed by Israeli officials, to \$5.6 billion. About half of that is exports from Israel to Turkey, and the other half, Turkish goods, like the cars, coming to Israel.

"The economies of

Turkey and Israel complement each other and the trade ties are flourishing," Israeli foreign ministry spokesman Emmanuel Nachshon told The Media Line. "That's the good news. Unfortunately the political ties are not as good, and this is a consequence of the harsh attack by the Turkish leadership against Israel."

Ties between Israel and Turkey have foundered since Israeli naval commandos killed ten Turkish activists on a ship that was trying to break Israel's blockade of the Gaza Strip. Three years later, President Obama brokered a telephone apology from Israeli Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu for the deaths of the ten Turkish citizens, but relations have not returned to normal.

Israel and Turkey do not currently have ambassadors in each other's countries, but do have lowerlevel diplomatic representa-Turkish tives. Prime Minister Recep Tavvip Erdogan has consistently made anti-Israel comments including derogatory commenting on Netanyahu's trip to Paris after the killings at Charlie Hebdo and the kosher supermarket. Referring to last summer's fighting between Israel and the Islamist Hamas movement in the Gaza Strip, Erdogan said Netanyahu must "give an account for the children, women you massacred."

In response Israel's Foreign Minister Avigdor Lieberman called Erdogan an "anti-Semitic, neighbor-

OBAMA'S RECIPE FOR FIGHTING TERROR

U.S. PRESIDENT FALLS BACK ON "BOOT CAUSES" TO EXPLAIN ISIS

So it turns out the Obama Administration does have a strategy for combating terrorists: give them jobs.

In a remarkable exchange with MSNBC's "Hardball" host Chris Matthews on February 16, State Department spokeswoman Marie Harf said: "We cannot kill our way out of this war. We need in the medium to longer term to go after the root causes that lead people to join these

groups, whether it's a lack of opportunity for jobs, whether we can work with countries around the world to help improve their governance. We can help them build their economies so they can have job opportunities for these people."

Yet study after study of the motives of Arab and Muslim terrorists during the past two decades has found exactly the opposite.

Between 1996 and 1999, relief worker Nasra Hassan interviewed nearly 250 Palestinians who either attempted to carry out suicide bombings, or trained others for such attacks, or were related to deceased bombers. She reported (in The New Yorker): "None of [the bombers] were uneducated, desperately poor,

simple-minded, or depressed. Many were middle class and, unless they were fugitives, held paying jobs...Two were the sons of millionaires."

The attacks on September 11, 2001, focused new attention on the causes of terrorism. The *New York Times* reported that the personal details concerning the hijackers had "confounded the experts."

HAMAS OUTRAGED

EGYPTIAN COURT SAYS GROUP IS ILLEGAL

The Islamist Hamas party in Gaza is outraged over a recent Egyptian court's ruling that defined the party as a "'terrorist and an "illegal organization".



WHILE NO JEWS ARE left in the Kerala centers of Parur and Chennamangalam on the south west coast of India, and only a handful remain in Cochin, the Jewish historical presence in these communities is palpable to any visitor. In 2010 the Kerala government funded a project to restore the abandoned synagogue in Paravur, north of Kochi. Today the completed restoration is open to visitors. The synagogue was erected in 1164 and then rebuilt in 1616. Two stone pillars on the front signify the point which beuond Maharajah forbid non-Jews to pass on the Sabbath.

The ruling comes a few weeks after the same court branded Hamas's military wing the Izz-al-Din Al-Qassem Brigades a terrorist group and deepens the rift between Egypt and Hamas.

The Egyptian court decided that Hamas is a terrorist organization, following a petition, submitted by two local Egyptian lawyers, who earlier accused Hamas of involvement in terrorist attacks in the nearby Egyptian Sinai peninsula.

The court's verdict comes on top of a long series of accusations by local Egyptian media outlets that Hamas, which has ruled the Gaza Strip since 2007, has been behind a series of attacks that have killed dozens of Egyptian soldiers since August 2012.

hood bully."

That rhetoric has been stepped up in advance of the June, 2015 election for 550 new members of the Grand National Assembly, the Turkish parliament.

"We've repeatedly seen that whenever there is an election campaign there

is an increase in anti-Israel rhetoric." a senior Israeli official told The Media Line on condition of anonymity. "It's almost part of the electoral campaign, and the more anti-Israel vou are, the more popular you are.



Yet both Israel and Turkey seem happy to distinguish between their political and economic connections

"Both countries have built a wall between their political and diplomatic relations, and their economic ties," Alon Liel, a former director general of the Foreign Ministry told The "Both Media Line. economies are growing and their needs are growing. They decided that although they can fiercely quarrel on the diplomatic level, civilian trade has been almost unaffected."

Turkey is Israel's 7th or 8th largest trading partner, he said. Israel exports chemicals like potash to Turkey, and imports manufactured goods and food.

In the late 1990's Israel also made extensive arms deals with Turkey for upgrading its aircraft and tanks, and even selling it drones. Those deals have been put on hold based on the tense political situa-

Alon Liel says that both Israel and Turkey have become increasingly isolated in the Middle East, and if there was a solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. the two countries could reestablish their close political ties.

"Turkey didn't do very well in the last five years in the region," Liel said. "They ruined their relations with Syria and Egypt, and have problematic relations with Iraq and Iran. Turkey needs friends in the region."

That last sentence could be said of Israel as well, and the economic ties could form the basis for a new regional alliance in the future.

"They were adults with education and skill, not hopeless young zealots,' the Times said of the attackers. "At least one left behind a wife and young children...They were not reckless young men facing dire economic conditions and dim prospects, but men as old as 41 enjoying middle class lives.'

In 2002, Prof. Alan Krueger of Princeton and Prof. Jitka Maleckova of Prague's Charles University studied the lives of 129 Lebanese Hezbollah terrorists who were killed in attacks on Israel. They found that as compared to other Lebanese, the Hezbollah members "were less likely to come from poor families and were significantly more likely to have

completed secondary education."

That same year, the Muslim writer Hala Jaber spent four days with Fatah's Al Aksa Martyrs Brigade, She found that their members were "educated and middle class."

2004, Prof. In Alberto Abadie of Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government undertook a study of terrorists' motives. When he started, thought that "it was a reasonable assumption that terrorism has its roots in poverty." By the time he was done, he had concluded that there is "no significant relationship" between the economic conditions in a given country and the rise of terrorists there.


And do President Obama and his aides still stubbornly cling to the utterly unscientific idea that poverty causes terrorism?

serves the interests of the (Israel)," Zionist entity Yehva Alabdsa, a local leading figure of Hamas told The Media Line. "The Zionists are surely happy for such a ruling and I believe that they now consider the leader of the coup in Egypt, Egyptian president Abdel Fattah al-Sisi, as a national hero."

Alabadsa believed that though the ruling is "quite dangerous", Egypt's military will not take any action against Hamas. He said Hamas' main enemy remains Israel, after last summer's fighting between the two left at least 2100 Palestinians dead, along with 72 Israelis, mostly sol-

"Our enemy remains the Zionist occupation and once the Zionists attempt to attack us, we will point our guns against the Zionists, themselves," he said. "I do believe that the Egyptian society cannot be misled by the court ruling and that the people there understand that our party is a national Palestinian movement that is only dedicated for the liberation of Palestine."

A leading imam in Gaza, Younis Alastal, of the

Gaza-based Association of Muslim Scholars, says the ruling actually shows the strength of Hamas.

"The recent court's

ruling has provided a free advertising campaign on behalf of Hamas, as those who have not yet learned (Please turn to page 13)



THE YASSIN FATHER AND SONS TEAM ENGRAVES JEWISH TOMBSTONES IN MUMBAI



FOR MORE THAN 40 YEARS MUHAMMAD ABDUL Yassin(left) has come to the Bene Israel cemetery in Mumbai, India, every day except Friday, to engrave Jewish headstones. Yassin was raised in a poverty stricken area of Northern India but was determined to move away as soon as he could to seek a better life. By the age of 27 Yassin had begun developing his craft. He received word that the Jewish tombstone engraver in Mumbai, Aaron Menasse Navgavikar, was looking for an apprentice. Yassin became that apprentice, learning not only the craft but six new languages as well. In 1971 Navgavikar and his family moved to Israel and Yassin not only became the engraver for the Bene Israel but for the Baghdadis Jews as well. "They made me like their own", says Yassin. Today, Yassin, who suffered a heart attack several years ago, has given much of his work to his sons Islam(right) and Salam. Islam has been at his father's side for the past 34 years. Yassin says he is retired now but anyone who visits the Bene Israel cemetery will likely find Yassin helping his sons work on the roughly three tombstones a month that are needed. Yassin has had numerous invitations to make "aliya" but prefers to stay with his family in Mumbai.

about the party, will start learning about it," he told The Media Line. "Whatever repercussions could emerge out of such a ruling, Hamas will win. It does mean that the party is a strong one that is feared even by nearby Egypt. How could a tiny coastal enclave pose a threat to a great country, like Egypt?"

He also said that Egypt has not provided any evidence that Hamas has been involved in hostile attacks across Egypt.

"I believe that the ruling would fuel tension in Egypt as many in Egypt love Hamas, for Hamas is working on behalf of the whole nation", he said.

Hamas is an offshoot of the Muslim Brotherhood, and under Egypt's former President Mohamed Morsi, ties were close. Morsi was deposed in 2013 and is currently on trial

Gaza-based political analyst, Naji Shurrab, believes that the court's ruling, will have an impact on the political scene in the region.

"The ruling will encourage Israel to further isolate the Islamist Hamas party, by possibly carrying out another attack against Gaza, like it did last summer. Yet. I would rather believe that Israel will exploit the ruling against Hamas in international courts, like the European or the International Court of Justice", Shurrab told The Media Line

At the same time, he said, neither Hamas nor Egypt is interested in a military confrontation, and the ruling will have little



practical significance.

Ibrahim Abrash, another political analyst in Gaza, told The Media Line that Palestinian parties such as the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) must intervene.

"If Hamas cannot assign lawyers in Egypt to appeal against the court's ruling, then I think the Palestine Liberation Organization should do that on behalf of Hamas," he told The Media Line. "I believe the ruling might lead some Arab countries like Saudi Arabia and UAE, which are connected closely Egypt, to start dealing with the Islamist Hamas, quite differently."



CHABAD CENTRE RE-OPENS IN MUMBAI, INDIA



Charges Dropped At Ohio U

Four Jewish students at the University of Yulish, Ohio. Jonah Maxwell Peltz, Rebecca Sebo and Gabriel Sirkin, have had charges of disrupting a student senate meeting dropped. They faced up to 30 days in jail and a \$250 fine after being arrested by university police for staging a protest against senate president Megan Marzec's "blood bucket challenge" video calling for the university to support the BDS movement. The students turned down the offer of pleading guilty to a misdemeanor charge of disorderly conduct and a \$100 fine.

A jury trial had been set to start on September 10th. The charges were dropped following motions filed by lawyers for the students claiming that their clients had not received a "speedy trial" which under Ohio laws means within 60 days.

Hain Celestial Buys Empire Foods

Irwin Simon, president and CEO of Hain Celestial Group, one of the largest sellers of natural and organic foods in the United States, has bought the 80 per cent of Empire Kosher Holdings that it did not own. Empire's sales in 2014 were an estimated \$100 million. Simon, who was born in Glace Bay, Nova Scotia in 1958 and as a kid stocked shelves at his father's Simon Dairy, says that "Empire expands our Farm to Table product offerings, a growing category that appeals to those seeking 'the pure food trend', including our core natural and organic consumers." Simon plans on diversifying Empire's products.

Jew vs Jew In Rockland County

Rockland County, about 30 miles north of midtown Manhattan, has had a rough few years. It's been named New York's most fiscally stressed community and home values are down some 18 per cent.

Jews make up about one-third of the county's population of 320,000 but it's the rapidly growing Hasidic community that is causing friction, not only between the Orthodox and their non-Jewish neighbours but with Reform and Conservative Jews as well. The Hasidic have made life so uncomfortable for the non-Orthodox that many have moved away. Conservative and Reform synagogue membership is dwindling and the one non-Orthodox Jewish day school has seen its enrolment plummet.

But the Hasidic antics are not just causing

problems for Jews. The Orthodox have become a powerful political machine and the struggle over the funding decisions of East Ramapo Central School District has brought matters to a head.

The ultra-Orthodox control the majority of seats on the board. Somehow the local yeshivas are prosperelementary while schools don't have budgets for assistant principals, art classes, social workers or after school sports. And the community, Jew and Gentile, has had enough. While Reform and Conservative Jews, who for years stayed silent, may support comments describing the Orthodox as "locust swarms of non tax paying looters", they do believe that the "financial abuse of Rockland by the Hasidic-Orthodox community", must stop.

Emboldened Reform and Conservative Jews have also decided that the time has come to stop apologizing for all the "bad stuff" people read about Rockland County. The local Jewish Federation, along with Reform and Conservative

leaders, has launched a campaign to stop the exodus from Rockland and to convince Jews living elsewhere that their county is really "a beautiful place to live."




