Debating a Strike on Iran

Ronen Bergman, an Israeli expert on strategic affairs, believes that the three major factors for an Israeli strike on Iran are now in place: international legitimacy, Israel's capability and the necessity to act. Israeli Minister for Strategic Affairs, Moshe Yaalon, responding to those who question Israel's capability to launch a preemptive strike, told the Herzliya Conference that "any facility that is guarded by a human being, can be penetrated by a human being. It is possible to strike at all the facilities in Iran militarily, and I can say that from my experience as chief of staff". The threat, moreover, of Iranian retaliation is, some conclude, overblown. "There will not be 100,000 dead, "says Defence Minister Ehud Barak, "or 10,000 dead of 1000 dead. The State of Israel will not be destroyed".

Other Israelis are not convinced of the wisdom of immediate action. Former Mossad chief Meig Dagan believes a military strike now would be the "stupidest thing I have ever heard." Retired Israeli military intelligence head Maj-Gen. Amos Yadkin echoes these comments arguing that if and when Iran makes the decision to get the bomb, there will still be time for a strike to be ordered. Adds Shlomo Brom, a general retired from Israel intelligence and former deputy national security advisor, "assuming that once they do make a decision to weaponize, we will know it...There is a window of time from the point of making the decision and until they succeed in weapon making". Indeed, some within the Israeli Defence Forces believe it could be as late as 2018 before Iran has nuclear operation capability.

There is some general agreement among military personnel both in Israel and within the international community. Even the most optimistic military commanders in the IDF admit that Israel cannot completely wipe out Iran's nuclear capabilities. Senior officers are on record as saying "we will have to go back to Iran a second time" and that "we have no illusion that we can delay their plans by more than two or three years." Moreover, a large scale operation against Iran would quite likely mean strikes against Iranian missile launchers in Lebanon, Gaza and maybe even Syria. Such operations would stretch IAF resources, even if not beyond its capabilities. Bombing Iran would mean Israeli pilots would have to fly more than 1000 miles across unfriendly air space, refuel in the air en route, fight off Iran's air defenses, use at least 100 planes and attack multiple underground sites all at the same time. "I don't think you'll find anyone who'll say, 'Here's how it's going to be done - handful of planes, over an evening, in and out,'", says Andrew R. Hoehn, director of the Rand Corporation's Project Air Force.

The Jewish Standard believes that while all options must remain on the table a pre-emptive Israeli attack at this point is premature, even if Iran continues to hit "soft" Jewish targets around the world. Sanctions are having an impact. Mysterious explosions have killed scientists and destroyed missile plants. Computer worms have set back research programs. We are by no means suggesting that the rhetoric from Jerusalem, or from its neoconservative allies in the United States, should be toned down. Nor do we think, as some incredibly naive observers suggest, that all it would take to stop Iran's nuclear program would be to treat Ahmedinejad with "respect". Mutual deterrence is not an option either. Iran is not a "rational actor". Its proxies in Lebanon and Gaza never consider how many of their own people might perish in a nuclear war.

Some fifty years ago, Levi Eshkol was being prodded by his ministers and the public to launch an attack on For several months Eshkol Egypt. resisted waiting, wisely as Michael Oren has pointed out, until he received the go-ahead from Lyndon Johnson. We think the current Israeli government would do well to follow Eshkol's lead, a view, according to one poll, shared by 80 percent of Israelis. Barak Obama may be cautioning Israel against "loose talk of war". But if Iran's threat to block the Straits of Hormuz is not a bluff, if sanctions ultimately prove to be insufficient, the president has stated unequivocally that he would then be prepared to use force to stop Iran's nuclear build-up. Yes, Israel alone has the right to determine its response to threats to its national security. But the last thing the country needs is further international isolation. We think it is in Israel's best interests if the US military doesn't have to be "sucked in" against its will to finish the job.

Basketball vs Shabbat

The Robert M. Beren Academy, an Orthodox Jewish school located in Houston, has a pretty good basketball team. After winning their regional game Beren earned the right to compete in the semi-finals. The problem was that the semi-finals were scheduled Friday March 2 and Saturday March 3 and the Academy asked the Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools to change the times of Beren's games.

Initially the request

was denied. TAPPS maintained that the game would have to be forfeited, claiming that its bylaws stipulated that the game must go forward.

URJ's Rabbi Rick Jacobs was at the forefront of the protest: "What message", he wrote, "would be sent to these scholar/athletes if they were forced to choose between their faith and their athletic goals? And what a powerful message TAPPS could send by finding an accommodation which would allow Beren to participate. Only the later choice could be true to our

shared American heritage of religious freedom". Among those joining in the protest were Houston Mayor Annise D. Parker and the former coach of the Houston Rockets Jeff Van Gundy.


When the protest fell on deaf ears, Nathan and Alyza Lewin, a father and daughter legal team based in Washington, decided to act. Nathan Lewin has argued several religious cases before the Supreme Court and knew that TAPPS had a very weak position. The Lewins asked the Dallas-based

firm of Carrington, Coleman, Sloman and Blumenthal to represented the Academy and all agreed to work pro bono.

While some parents were reluctant to join in the lawsuit, the complaint proceeded against the Mansfield Independent School District and TAPPS. And that's when TAPPs surrendered.

TAPPS reluctantly complied with Beren Academy's request and rescheduled the semifinal game for Friday



ISRAEL APARTHEID WEEK MUST BE FOUGHT

Anti-Israel hatred on campus crests each year during an event called "Israel Apartheid Week." With this ominous name and programs that thrive on ignorance and blind disregard for the facts, tens of thousands of college students are urged to rise up against Israel - painfully evoking the types of racist characterizations of the Jewish people defined attitudes once heard in Europe in the middle of the last century.

These campus initiatives were incubated in 2001 at the first Durban

Conference, proclaiming "no apartheid South Africa in the 20th century and no apartheid Israel in the 21st." This battle cry sparked the BDS movement calling for boycotts, divestment and sanctions to punish Israel, and it all evolved into an invective-loaded campaign that found a degree of favor on campuses coast to coast, not to mention among some labor unions, churches, media and cultural institutions. But it is based on a lie.

Typically, those these hurling charges against Israel hope that their audiences are ignorant of the facts. In apartheid South Africa, blacks were not allowed to use white hospitals, they could not attend white universities and they could not participate in the South African (Please turn to page 8)

TO BAN OR NOT TO BAN

DEBATING THE MERCHANT OF VENICE

Adolf Hitler's favorite Shakespearean drama is now at the center of an ironic tug of war in London, between a Jewish theater troupe that wants to perform it, and an anti-Israel group that wants to shut it down.

Wait, what?


There were no less than fifty productions of "The Merchant of Venice" in Nazi Germany during Hitler's first six years in power. Understandably, the fuhrer saw it as a powerful tool for advancing antisemitism. With its portrayal of the cruel and wily Shylock, the Jewish moneylender who lusts for "a pound of [Christian] flesh," the play in some ways encourages the worst medieval anti-Jewish stereotypes.

Not everyone sees it that way, of course. Actor Yossi Gerber, who portrayed Shylock in an earlier Israeli production of the play, says that Merchant - with its famous Shylock monologue about Jews being human like everyone else - is "antiantisemitic." Ilan Ronen, who will direct the new Habima version in London, says it "allows us to attack the hatred of Jews and fear of strangers."

As it happens, the opponents of the new production are upset not by the choice of "Merchant" but by the fact that the organizers London-based Shakespeare festival invited an Israeli troupe to participate. According to their web site, the protesters, known as Boycott from Within, re-(Please turn to page 11)

CHOOSING NON-VIOLENCE

PALESTINIANS ADOPT NON-VIOLENCE

Sami Awad is wrapping up a day of training with Palestinian women Bethlehem. leaders in another step in the effort to empower not only women, but to extend the concept and practice of non-violent popular resistance.

"At the theoretical level," Awad says. "I would say that the idea of non-violence is becoming more accepted. The criticism we had is going down."

"These women in this workshop are taking a very big role in the non-violence movement," Awad tells The Media Line. "We are doing this by talking to people who were marginalized or felt they were marginalized to help give them a very strong voice."

The Bethlehembased Holy Land Trust has become one of the most visible organizations promoting non-violent resistance as a Palestinian weapon.

"The misperception among Palestinians is that we are a bunch of peaceniks; peace-loving people trying to get along with the other side," says Awad, executive director of the trust. "That is not what we are promoting. We believe that non-violence taken as a popular movement of resistance will be able to achieve the goals of the Palestinian people."

There is no doubt that the Palestinians have recognized the devastating toll on their society and political goals caused by the violence witnessed in the second Intifada from 2000 into 2005. Suicide bombings and attacks on Israeli civilians led to the Israeli army recapturing the West Bank in an iron-fisted crackdown that left more than 4,000 dead and more than 5,000 prisoners in Israeli jails along with colossal economic losses, territorial fragmentation incalculable social suffer-





parliament. Visit Hadassah Hospital today, or any other health facility in Israel, and see Jewish and Arab doctors caring for Jewish and Arab patients. Witness for yourself Hebrew at University or any institution of higher learning as Jewish and Arab professors teach students of different backgrounds. Go Knesset, and observe the debates involving both Jewish and Arab parliamentarians.

Given this reality, Justice Richard Goldstone, a former judge on the South African Supreme Court wrote in the New York Times on October 31, 2011: "The charge that Israel is an apartheid state is a false and malicious one that precludes, rather than promotes, peace and harmony." Goldstone, it should be remembered, did not have a problem criticizing Israeli policies in the aftermath of its 2008-2009 military operation in the Gaza Strip.

But when it came to calling Israel an apartheid state like the old South Africa, with which he was intimately familiar, he firmly rejected the charge which was completely divorced from the reality of Modern Israel.

No nation fought racism more consistently than the Jewish people, whether through the anti-apartheid activists in the South African Jewish community or through those American Jews who joined the civil rights movement and locked arms with Martin Luther King, Jr. The Jewish state was founded on the very same moral outlook. reflecting Jewish value of Tikkun Olam, or repairing the world, which is deeply held across the Jewish religious spectrum. When Israeli medical teams rushed to international disaster zones in Turkey (1999), (1999),Kosovo the Democratic Republic of the Congo (2008), and Haiti,

helping the afflicted regardless of their race or creed. they were driven by the very same core Jewish value.

to many others before them.

when one notes how the Shylock slur has been used by some Arab denouncers of Israel. In a sermon last year, Muhammad Badi, leader of Egypt's Muslim Brotherhood, cited Shylock as revealing "the true character" of Jews, while Hafez Barghouti, editor of the Palestinian Authority newspaper Al-Hayat Al-Jedida, has described Israel as "the Shylock of the lands and settlement" and Israeli banks as "Shylock-style banks that empty our pockets."

American Jewish defense organizations have long been concerned about the impact of the stereotypes in The Merchant for Venice, and for good reason. Shylock references abound in American literature going back to the 19th century and even seeped into the political arena. Just weeks after General Ulysses Grant expelled all Jewish merchants from Union-occupied areas of Tennessee. Mississippi, and Kentucky 1862. Confederate congressman Tennessee Henry Foote declared that unless the Confederacy took similar steps, "the end of the war would probably find nearly all the property of the Confederacy in the hands of Jewish shylocks."

As early as 1912, the Central Conference American (Reform) Rabbis urged the College Entrance Board Examination remove Merchant from its lists of plays "to be intensively studied" as a prerequisite to college admission. The Anti-Defamation League in 1917 launched a campaign to ban the study of Merchant in American high schools on the grounds that "Shylock is erroneously pictured as typical of all Jews." Several hundred schools acceded to the ADL's request.

TO BAN OR NOT TO BAN

After World War II, perhaps reflecting the fact that American Jews now felt more secure in American society, the ADL changed its position. When parents in Brooklyn in 1950 tried to force the New York City Board of Education to drop 'The Merchant of Venice" (and Oliver Twist, with its repulsive Jewish villain, Fagin) from high school curricula, the ADL likened the effort to "book-burning."

There is, however, a middle ground between banning a controversial play and presenting it, unvarnished, to audiences that might not appreciate the context or implications of what they are viewing. Perform the play, but have a historian speak before it begins, and have a panel discussion when it concludes. In classrooms, use The Merchant of Venice as a teachable moment, just as teachers confront issues of racial stereotyping when their students read, for example, The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn.

Bernard Weinraub's hit off-Broadway play, "The Accomplices", stirred its share of controversy in 2007-2010, with its frank of President account Franklin Roosevelt's indifference to the Holocaust and the efforts by the Bergson Group activists to shake America's science. I was invited to take part in a post-performance "Talkback" on stage, along with the playwright, several of the actors, and Dr. Rebecca Kook, Peter Bergson's daughter. The discussion helped clarify historical and moral issues that the play raised.

A similar approach to "The Merchant of Venice," whether in London or anywhere else, might help make the best of an otherwise bad situation.

heavily on the minds of non-violence Palestinian activists is the inherent negative effect of the involvement of international and even Israeli volunteers. Some argue their presence risks portraying this kind of resistance as something not emanating from within the Palestinian community, supported primarily from without.

"At one point, there were more internationals than Palestinians, but now we are at a different level of thinking. Also, many internationals and Israelis are coming, not to try and end the occupation, but to see what they can do to support us in ending the occupation," Awad tells The Media Line.



ponents. Only 2 per cent of the Palestinian population is Christian and none live in areas like Nablus, Jenin and Qalqilya, where there is growing involvement, he says.

What is preventing the non-violence movement from really taking off, they say, is the lack of charismatic leadership, vision, unity and strategy - a Palestinian Gandhi.

"I would still say that there is not a nonviolent movement in Palestine because we are still in a reactionary state. We have to be proactive. This is the challenge for us and that is what we are engaged in at the moment," Awad says. "We are not there yet."

During last September's initiative by President Mahmoud Abbas to win recognition of statehood and full membership in the United Nations, mass nonviolent protests were organized in the Palestinian territories. Orchestrated by Palestinian **Popular** Committees across the West Bank, they failed to achieve hoped-for because Israelis neither saw nor cared about them. Ironically, the low profile that kept the demonstrations beneath the radar came largely because the Palestinian Authority did not want to provoke Israel to respond with military force.

At the moment, the Palestinians are mainly interested in the reconciliation negotiations being held between Hamas and Fatah, which is taking up a lot of

their energy and less in the statehood efforts. Yet they are inspired by the Arab Spring.

"What we see in the Arab Spring is that this was the voice of the majority and while this is Western thinking, we see this now as part of our culture and I think this is our role model."

think this is our role model," Awad said.

One of their main obstacles is the simple semantics of the term "nonviolence." In Arabic it is "laumph," or "no-violence." Some argue that it sounds as if it is negating something, like the right to fight back. For this reason, activists use the terms "civil resistance," "popular resistance," or "political defiance."

This is important, Awad explains, because in the Palestinian Arab culture, pacifism is seen as a sign of weakness.

Palestinians claim the Israeli army has developed a culture of hostility toward peace activists by defining them as the enemy condoning violent behavior toward them by soldiers. Some involved in protests have said that organizers sometimes put a quota on the number of internationals and Israelis at demonstrations in order to make certain that the majority were Palestinians.

"To build a movement you need to show that it is a local movement and what has happened with non-violence is a dependence on internationals and Israelis; a sense that if they are not there then we can't do anything," Awad says. "Part of it is fear of not having this shield and part is a lack of self-confidence."



Australian police are seeking the extradition of child molester David Kramer, currently in a US prison on other sex related charges, on of suspicion having abused children at a Chabad school in Melbourne during the 1990s. But Kramer is apparently not the only molester to end up in the United States after local community leaders failed to take the appropriate action. And he, like others, ended up as youth leader at a Orthodox synagogue in the United States.

Manny Waks, former vice-president of the Executive Council of Australian Jewry, has accused Velvel Serebryanski, the son of a Chabad rabbi, and now living in New York, of molesting him at two Melbourne synagogues in the 1980s. Australian police are currently investigating more than a dozen Orthodox individuals suspected of child abuse in Australia who with the help of local authorities were able to flee to the United States.

The late Rabbi Yitzchok Groner, former head of the Yeshivah Centre, is being targeted for failing to act when various cases brought to his attention.
