

The Refugee Dilemma

We are not denying the suffering of millions of innocent refugees fleeing Syria, Lebanon Iraq, and Afghanistan. Though we would not, as some have done, compare their plight to that of the Jews of Nazi Germany, scenes of desperate men, women and children, crammed onto flimsy rubber dinghies, demand that we not leave these hordes of dislocated souls to fend for themselves.

But we cannot ignore the fact that one of the barbarians involved in the slaughter in Paris entered Europe through the Greek island of Leros masquerading as a refugee. can we act on compassion alone knowing that a large number of Sunni Syrian refugees are fleeing the brutality of Assad, not the soldiers of ISIL. refugees boarding planes every day for Canada are, we will acknowledge, "low risk". will have passed through the lax security points of entry in Greece, Serbia and Croatia. But how many have records and documentation and passports to show CBSA officials? How rigorous can the on the spot screening process be even in light of the revised timetable? Nor are we calmed by the argument that any of the refugees later found to have Islamist sympathies can Even if the vetbe sent back, ting process ferrets out a potential threat, the Canadian judicial system will ensure that his or her deportation becomes a long and tortuous legal quagmire. We're skeptical of the poll results cited by Ezra Levant as evidence of strong support for ISIL in the refugee camps. But arguing that it is "not likely" that ISIL will use the refugee crisis to slip operatives into Canada does little to allay our fears.

There is, however, a path Canada could have followed. Thousands of Yazidis are living in refugee camps in Turkey that "look like a jail". Chaldean Christians being systematically exterminated. They are at the bottom of the refugee heap. Mandaeans live in constant fear. These Yazidis Christians represent no threat to our security. They will not strap bombs to their vests in the name of Islamic purification. We could have opened doors immediately those who share our values, ideals and aspirations,

Yes, we are saying that all Muslims, even those fleeing our common enemy, must pay the price for the actions of those who shout Allahu Akbar as they proudly inflict as much carnage as they can. bleed for the Muslims who are begging us not to succumb to the danger of inertia. Certainly as Jews we know the pain involved in the struggle for self preservation. But we can't surrender to political correctness. Regrettably, bleed is all even Jews can do until each and every one of the adult refugees convinces the CBSA, CSIS and the RCMP that he or she will join with us in our pursuit of a "universal brotherhood."

Marco Rubio Getting a Second Look

Though he is still lagging in the polls, Marco Rubio's strong performances in recent Republican debates may be having an impact. Not only is the average American voter taking a second look at the Florida senator, but so, too, are potential wealthy backers. In fact, one such individual, billionaire hedge fund invester Paul Singer, has announced that he is backing Rubio because he is the only candidate who can "navigate this complex primary process and still be in a position to defeat Hillary Rodham Clinton". Singer, who lives in New York, gave more money to Republican candidates and causes last year than any other U.S. donor. He is on the board of Republican Jewish Coalition.

Singer, however, is not the single largest Jewish backer ot Rubio's presidential campaign. That honour belongs to billionaire auto dealership magnate Norman Braman, a past president of Miami Jewish Federation, In fact Braman and Rubio have a long history together. Braman helped finance Rubio's U.S. Senate run in 2010, hired his wife as a philanthropic advisor and even assisted Rubio with his personal finances. In 2010 Braman and Rubio went to Israel together.

Rubio's makes no apology for his staunchly pro-Israel stance. "If America doesn't stand with Israel, who would we stand with? If Israel - a democracy and strong American ally on the inter-

national stage - if they are not worthy of our unconditional support, then what ally of ours around world can feel safe in their alliance with us?" Rubio asked the Senate.

With Singer and Braman in his camp, the

next big question is where casino magnate Sheldon Adelson will go. It is known that the billionaire, who spent some \$150 million backing Republicans in the 2012 presidential campaign, "likes" the Florida senator. After Rubio declared that he

was running for president, the Adelson-owned Israeli newspaper, *Israel Hayom*, spoke glowingly of the candidate.





But in his 1986 book Inside the Promised Land Kaufman reveals his growing disenchantment with the Israeli government and many of its people. The war in Lebanon, the conflicts within Israeli society, the rise of the militant right, the treatment of Palestinians a11 led Kaufman to conclude that Israelis are now "prisoners within their own ghetto."

Over the years Kaufman has become increasingly vocal in his criticism of Israel and of Jews in general. His most recent tirade even earned him the scorn of British Labour Party leader Jeremy Corbyn, himself no friend of Israel's.

At a recent meeting of a pro-Palestinian organization Kaufman reportedly said: It's Jewish money, Jewish donations to the Conservative Party as in the general election in May, the (Please turn to page 20)



AT THE RECENT MEETING BETWEEN BENJAMIN Netanyahu and Barack Obama no mention was made of the Iran nuclear agreement in front of the cameras. And Netanyahu expressed his gratitude to the American president for his friendship and his contribution to Israel's security. For some this showed that the Israeli prime minister had "learned his lesson". But despite the photos of the two leaders smiling, the bitterness remains. The president, remarked one observer, "looked like a nervous passenger on a flight to nowhere, counting down the seconds left till it ends". Netanyahu tried to prolong the handshake near the end of their meeting, the president is seen trying to let go. The meeting between the two leaders may have lacked the tension of previous encounters but there is little doubt that the White House was more than happy to see President Reuven Rivlin. 
Christians have long lamented the commercialism which has submerged the pristine meaning of Christmas beneath an avalanche of materialism. Jews, looking about

WILL ISRAEL FOLLOW IRELAND?

WILL GAY COUPLES EVER BE ALLOWED TO MARRY IN ISRAEL?

In a few weeks Eli and Ron will celebrate their relationship with a wedding to be held at the Israel Museum in Jerusalem. There will be food, friends, music and a ceremony. But as far as the state of Israel is concerned, no marriage will have taken place, because the state does not recognize gay marriage. However, gay couples married outside Israel are registered as married on their return.

So shortly after their wedding, the newlyweds will fly to Denmark in order to hold a second wedding, one

that can be registered officially upon their return to Israel. Denmark is the ideal country for LGBT (Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender) couples to get married in, Eli Kaplan-Wildmann, told The Media Line. Not only does the Scandinavian country have some of the most progressive recognition of the rights of same-sex people to marry, it also doesn't have a residency requirement. While most secular Israelis go to Cyprus when they wish to marry outside of Israel's strict religious marriage laws, gay couples fly to

Denmark, Kaplan-Wildmann said, because same-sex marriage is not permitted in Cyprus.

All issues of personal status, including marriage and divorce, are under the control of the Orthodox authorities in rabbinic Israel, in a decision that goes back to the creation of the state. There is no civil marriage in Israel, only religious marriage, although civil marriages are retroactively recognized by the government. The issue of gays is especially problematic, as the Bible calls homosexual sex an "abomination" which

should be punished with execution.

Kaplan-Wildmann, an Orthodox Jewish theater director, says Israeli society, and even the more liberal parts of the Orthodox world, accept his sexual orientation.

"We hold hands in the street," he told The Media Line. "Israel is more open to LGBT rights than a lot of other countries. There is a sense that Israel has bigger issues to deal with."

In fact, Tel Aviv is considered a gay cultural capital to rival the reputa-

NEW BOOK ACCUSES RABBI STEPHEN WISE OF UNDERMINING JEWISH DISSIDENTS

America's foremost Jewish leader in the 1940s took extreme steps to prevent Jewish dissidents from challenging President Roosevelt's weak response to the Holocaust, according to a new book.

"Rabbi Stephen S. Wise actively undermined Jewish dissidents--from both the left and the right-who tried to challenge the Roosevelt administration's abandonment of European Jewry," said Dr. Rafael Medoff, author of the new book, The Anguish of a Jewish Leader: Stephen S. Wise and the Holocaust. "To prevent activists from having a voice in Jewish pol-

The David S. Wyman Institute for Holocaust Studies, located in Washington, D.C., is a research and education institute focusing on America's response to the Holocaust. It is named in honor of the eminent historian and author of the 1984 best-seller The Abandonment of the Jews, the most important and influential book concerning the U.S. response to the Nazi genocide

cymaking, Wise suppressed their rallies, urged members of Congress to boycott them, pressured newspapers to refuse their advertisements, and even encouraged government officials to 'draft or deport' activist leaders."

The Anguish of a Jewish Leader' is Dr. Medoff's sixteenth book on the Holocaust and Jewish history. It is the first major scholarly study of Rabbi

Wise in more than 30 years, and the first ever booklength study of Wise's response to the Holocaust.

Additional highlights from the book:

• President Theodore Roosevelt repeatedly promised Rabbi Wise that he would help rescue Jewish refugees and create a Jewish state, but never did so. In one instance, the president assured Wise (in 1944) that he would issue a

a strong statement supporting Zionism, but then FDR watered down Wise's draft to avoid an explicit commitment to Jewish statehood.

- In postwar interviews, many of Rabbi Wise's closest friends and colleagues argued that Wise's personal and political devotion to FDR undermined his willingness to challenge Roosevelt's lethargic response to the Holocaust.
- Rabbi Wise's medical problems severely hampered his ability to mobilize the Jewish community to respond to the Holocaust; and the lack of democracy in the organizations that

RUDE AWAKENING

ISRAELI PEACE ACTIVIST LEARNS A LESSON

An Israeli peace activist who has devoted much of his life to demanding that Israel make more concessions to the Palestinians was treated to a rude awakening earlier this month on a Minnesota campus: it turns out that pro-Palestinian advocates don't just hate Israeli policy -- they hate all Israelis, including Israeli peace activists.

Hebrew University professor Moshe Halbertal was invited to deliver the University of Minnesota's annual Dewey Lecture in the Philosophy of Law. Unfortunately, the Palestinian and pro-Palestinian activists on campus don't have very much respect for the philosophy of law, at least not the laws that protect freedom of speech. Two dozen hecklers tried to drown out Halbertal

by shouting "denunciations of Israel" (as the local press described it) and accusing Halbertal of being "a war crimes apologist."

Ironically, in his remarks (after the hecklers were removed), Prof. Halbertal suggested that Israeli soldiers were not doing enough to protect enemy civilians during warfare. Since that was his position, Halbertal must have been puzzled that the Palestinian advocates would attack him so fiercely.

Welcome to the real world, Moshe Halbertal. Criticizing Israeli polices is not enough. When the hecklers called him a "war crimes apologist," they weren't referring to one or two particular alleged war crimes. They consider the very existence of the State of Israel to be a war crime.



tions of Berlin or San Francisco, and in 2012 was voted the most popular city in the world by gay travel-

Yet many gays say they would like to be able to get married in Israel. The issue has come to the fore after Ireland, long considered a conservative Catholic stronghold - so much so that divorce only became legal in 1995 - has become the first ever country to recognize same-sex unions through a referendum. Could a similar popular movement occur in Israel?

"The law has to catch up," Kaplan-Wildmann explained. "I look forward to more equality but gay marriage is not the main issue," he said, adding that a change in the legal system to allow civil partnership for all citizens is the priority.

"We don't focus on (gay) marriage - other issues are focused on, as a more practical (solution)," to inequality, Tom Canning, Director of Development at the Open House for Pride

and Tolerance, told The Media Line. The Open House is a LGBT non-governmental organization which has been active in Jerusalem since 1997, campaigning for equality for homosexuals.

Canning said samesex marriage will never be recognized as long as the rabbinate controls the rules surrounding marriage. The ultra-Orthodox parties are also a key part of Israeli Prime Minister Binyamin Netanyahu's ruling coalition, and all past efforts to legalize civil marriage or gay marriage have failed.

"The connection between (it) and the state is too strong for this to happen," Canning said. His organization would prefer a more liberal form Judaism to gain influence in the Rabbinate, one which would benefit the LGBT community, he said.

Everything that has been achieved for LGBT rights has been won through the courts rather than through the political

REMEMBER, REFLECT, **RECOMMIT - YAD VASHEM'S "NEW" SITE**



OVER SIX HUNDRED PEOPLE RECENTLY attended a ceremony at Earl Bales park to show support for the Canadian Society for Yad Vashem's newly revitalized Wall of Remembrance, made possible through its "Remember, Reflect, Recommit Campaign". The new commemorative elements within the renovated site include walls, pillars, gardens, monuments, and a six-branched Yad Vashem Menorah located in the central square. Two wallsites are of particular interest. One wall, "The Ed and Fran Sonshine Children's Memorial Wall," is dedicated to the children who perished in the Holocaust, On this wall the names of 365 children who were murdered in the Shoah are engraved, corresponding to each day of the calendar year and the child's birthday. This wall will also acknowledge those Canadian children who have adopted a "twin," that is a child Holocaust victim, through Yad Vashem Twinning Program, which pairs children of bar and bat mitzvah age with a child Holocaust victim matched by name or birthday. Fran and Ed Sonshine and daughter, Jodi Tanentzap, are seen on the front cover. The other wall, "The Drimmer Family True Heroes Wall." is dedicated to the Righteous Among the Nations, non-Jews who risked their lives to rescue Jews during the Holocaust. This wall features the engraved flags of 50 countries from which Righteous Among the Nations originated, engravings of the medal and certificate bestowed by Yad Vashem on Righteous Among the Nations, and the names of Righteous Among the Nations whose descendants now live in Canada and who have been honoured by the Canadian Society for Yad Vashem.

arena, Canning said. Despite popular support for gay rights, politicians do not push for legislation because of strong opposition from the ultra-Orthodox.

Gay couples are not the only people unable to marry under Israel's marital laws. As religious authorities have control of weddings, marriages must be between two people of the same religion. A Jew cannot legally marry a Muslim or a Christian.

"The state has a long arm that causes a lot of suffering," Irit Rosenblum, Founder and CEO of New Family, told The Media Line. The problem is the ties between state and religion, Rosenblum said, explaining that she believed that the relationship between two human beings should not be dictated by a government.

A spokesperson for the Orthodox Rabbinate declined to comment in detail, saying simply that if changes were to be made in future they would have to be made in the Knesset.

Other Orthodox representatives said that the law against civil marriage helps guarantee the Jewish future of the state of Israel. The consequences of the law for homosexual couples and others unable to marry are understood and regrettable, Ziv Maor, a former spokesperson for the Rabbinate, told The Media Line, but the law is necessary.

"Throughout history few nations have ceased to exist because of genocide – most nations which ceased to exist, did so because of assimilation," he said. "The price gay – and some heterosexual – couples pay for not being able to marry is enormous," Maor conceded, admitting that it was a price that he personally did not have to bear. As the Israeli

army protects Israel from violence and anti-Semitism, he said, the country's religious marital laws protected it from assimilation.

a referendum, with the same question as Ireland's - that "marriage may be contracted in accordance with the law by two people without distinction as to their sex" - was called in Israel now it would pass, Canning of the Open House asserts. HAND IN HAND -SEEKING A SHARED SOCIETY IN ISRAEL



FOR HAND IN HAND, THE CENTRE FOR Jewish-Arab Education in Israel their motto "Learning together, Living together", is more than just a slogan: it is a driving principle of their efforts to build a Jewish-Arab partnership and equality in Israel. In six communities throughout Israel, with a record 1350 Arab and Jewish students enrolled, the schools continue to help young Jews and Arabs grow up knowing that "We, Jews and Arabs, refuse to be enemies." "This place isn't just a school — it's a home. We are breaking the cycle of hatred and bringing that to the world around us", say 11th grade Arab and Jewish students Ranim and Emmanuel. Hand in Hand schools have been repeatedly targeted by vandals. Schools have been torched by right-wing fanatics and vandals have scrawled slogans such as "Kahane was right" and "There's no co-existence with cancer" on the walls of the schools. But Hand in Hand schools have been in existence now for almost 20 years and offer at least a reason to hope that the waves of violence will one day come Meanwhile the municipality of to an end. Jerusalem has filed a civil lawsuit against three men convicted of the arson attack on the Max Rayne Hand in Hand School last November. The lawsuit seeks more than half a million shekels (\$130,000) in damages, which includes costs for repairing the building as well as money for the psychological treatment of children traumatized by the attack. Brothers Nahman and Shlomo Twitto were convicted and sentenced to two and a half years in prison. Yitzhak Gabai is awaiting sentencing. All three are members of the Lehava organization whose goal is to prevent co-existence between Arabs and Jews.

Halbertal was discovered by the "Times" to be a 'useful Israeli' even before he had entered the academic world. - Halbertal "disapproved" of an Israeli strike on a terrorist leader in Gaza, because some of the terrorist's relatives were nearby and were harmed. (Jan. 13, 2009)
- Halbertal participated in weekly vigils in a mostly-Arab neighborhood in Jerusalem to demand that Jews not be allowed to move into the area. The Ku Klux Klan would have been proud. (March 10, 2010)





EDUCATORS RETURN FROM YAD VASHEM



With the world's recent escalation in human atrocity, violence, and the breakdown of human values, teaching about social justice issues to Canadian students through the prism of the Holocaust is more crucial than ever. Educators from acrosss Canada now address these and other issues in their multicultural Canadian classrooms and communities after returning from the annual 3-week Holocaust Education Seminar at Yad Vashem, Jerusalem's International School for Holocaust Studies. Each of the educators will now bring his or her own perspective to deal with these challenges and to answer these questions of concern to parents and students:

Why should we learn about the Holocaust? Is the Holocaust a unique genocide or as just one among others?

How do we connect the establishment and existence of Israel to Holocaust education?

How do we teach the Holocaust to students from

a multitude of ethnic and religious affiliations?

"Nazi Grandma" Sent to Jail

Ursula Haverbeck has a long history of defying German law. Now, the 87-year-old will spend ten months in jail for telling a Hamburg court that the Nazis' Auschwitz death camp is "only a belief".

In April Haverbeck was charged with Holocaust denial after stating on television at the trial of former SS guard Oskar Groning that the Holocaust was "the biggest and most

tainable lie in history".

Magistrate Bjoern Joensson, who handed down the sentence, said it was "deplorable that this woman, who is still so active given her age, uses her energy to spread such hair-raising nonsense".

Haverbeck intends to appeal the sentence.

A New Friend for Israel and Jews

The election in Argentina has resulted in a president determined to repair relations with the Jewish community and not to apologize for any Argentinian ties to Israel.

President elect

Mauricio Macri has indicated he intends to cancel the agreement signed with Iran to jointly investigate the 1994 attack on the AMIA Jewish center in Buenos Aires. The agreement drew the aire of Argentina's Jewish community given the evidence that Iran was behind the AMIA bombing, which killed 85. The death of Alberto Nisman remains suspicious.

Macri's ties to the Jewish community are no secret. As mayor of Buenos Aires his government encouraged Argentinians to apply the lessons of the Israeli "Start-Up Nation". Budding entrepreneurs went to Israel and described their experiences

on the government's website.

Macri himself visited Israel as part of the mayor's conference 2014. He told journalists that "Israel suffering has to be understood. From afar. it is easy to give advice..." In 2013 Macri hand picked Rabbi Sergio Bergman to run for the national legislature. Bergman was victorious and became the first rabbi to serve as a national lawmaker. Macri counts other Jewish politicians as his friends and advisors.

On the day of the election Macri played soccer with friends against the over 45 team that will represent Argentina at the Pan American Maccabi Games in Chile.
