

## Israel at 74

That Israel should have survived for three quarters of a century is no less than a miracle. A collectivity of some half a million individuals, drawn from a variety of nations, a mixture of economic backgrounds and religious orientations, united in the recreation of a political and national entity that has defied historical expectations. Israel has succeeded against the of a hundred million challenge Arabs, virtually all of whom, at least until recently, sworn to her destruction. It was achieved in atmosphere which was the product of millenia of Judeophobia. Israel has survived for seven decades because of her courage, her determination and her willingness to make the sacrifices essential to her survival. Anything less would have condemned the nation to extinction.

Today Israel must face the future courageously and aggressively. The Abraham Accords are a welcome development and the ties between Israel and the UAE, as evidenced by the recent Free Trade Agreement, are stronger than anyone could have imagined. Despite lingering tensions between Israel and Jordan and public misgivings in Egypt the uneasy peace is holding firm. Consultations between the two militaries frequent and senior Israeli officers from the IDF have made regular visits to Egypt. The recent Negev Summit, which included Egypt, Bahrain, Morocco and the UAE (with Jordan attending future meetings) is helping, in the words of the Israeli Foreign Ministry, "to build a regional security architecture that will build deterrence against threats from the archenemy, Iran." Yet hatred of Israel among those Arab entities who refuse to acknowledge its existence may well intensify from one generation to another. Terrorist groups within Israel and throughout Gaza are not suddenly going to disappear. The belief that "Palestine" is part of some Islamic inheritance, the conviction that Islam is poised to make a resurgence which will make it once again the powerful nation it was centuries ago, still dominates much of Islamic thinking.

Israel must also resolve, or at least mitigate, pressing internal problems tearing increasingly at the nation's fragile unity. Jews have long been a fractious people. Religious convictions are often a unifying force. They may also be a deeply divisive one and Israel is suffering a polarizing struggle between religious and secular entities. Israel's unstable political situation, with all governments dependent for survival on splinter groups willing to go to extraordinary lengths to achieve their often narrow objectives, means that a "few" can hold the majority to ransom.

And yet despite having to contend with the soaring cost of living and doing so under the almost daily threat of being in the wrong place at the wrong time and notwithstanding the deepening internal fissures, the recent United Nations World Happiness Report ranked Israel 9th on its world list, up for 12th last year and the country's highest rating ever. Israel scores high on life satisfaction, economics, health, social support and generosity. "I think", says Anat Fanti, a PhD candidate specializing in well-being, "it's a mix of Israeli pride and optimism."

We don't doubt Fanti's research. But there's something else. In Israel Jews, including the 400 recent arrivals from Ethiopia, never have to worry that their country's leader will one day announce that he intends to stop the "bloodsucking" Jews from "spreading like weeds."

### "Death to the Palestinians" -In Iran?

Sheina Vojoudi is an Iranian dissident who fled the Islamic Republic because she refused to submit to the repressive regime. She and others were not surprised when a group of her fellow countrymen chanted "death to Palestine" during the al-Quds protest calling for Israel's destruction. Says Vojoudi: believe it's very important to know that the people you see in the pictures are not there because of al-Quds day, they're just there because many of them have no other choice. Believe me, there will be no al-Quds demonstration in Iran if these people were not under pressure."

"Iranian people in Sirjan chanting: Death to

Palestine! It shows the absurd ideology of the theocratic regime & terrorist Shia mullahs in Tehran which supports the Terrorists Israel! against Iranian people are supporting Peace & have no problem with Israel or the USA at all", adds Erfan Fard, a counterterrorism expert.

### Banning Nazi Symbols

Oueensland, Australia will become the second state in the country to ban the public display of the swastika and other Nazi symbols. The move, says Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk, will ensure that extremists are "called out and confronted". "These crimes", she continued,"are not harmless. Nor are their

ideologies".

The premier's decision came after a Nazi flag was displayed in the window of a block of flats near the Brisbane synagogue. A parliamentary committee also recommended that the bill cover social media and internet displays.

No plans are being made to make exceptions for Hindus, Buddhists and Jains, for whom swastikas are religious symbols.

There are an estimated 112,000 Jews in Australia, making it the 9th largest Jewish population.

It is worth noting that

in what would be a first for an official piece of U.S. hate crimes legislative bill, the California's state Assembly has added language differentiating the Nazi swastika from the swastika symbol used in art and worship for Hindus, Buddhists and Jains.

### Jews On Time's Most Influential

# WALKING WITH ISRAEL

15,000 TORONTO JEWS HIT THE STREETS FOR ISRAEL

On the morning of Sunday, May 29, thousands of members of Toronto's Jewish community gathered in Earl Bales Park for the 53rd iteration of the UJA-sponsored, seven kilometre 'Walk with Israel'. The UJA estimates that approximately 15,000 people took part in the walk.

were welcomed by keynote speaker Linda Frum, a renowned author, journalist and former Conservative member of the Senate. Other guest speakers included Idit Shamir, Consul General of Israel in Toronto and Western Canada and Alon Davidi, Mayor of the besieged coastal city of Sderot.

Steve McDonald, Vice President of Communications and Marketing for the UJA, said that the opportunity for the city's Jewish community to express support for Israel was long overdue. Indeed,

# HISTORIAN CENSORED BY RUSSIAN TV

RENOWNED HOLOCAUST DIRECTOR REFUSED TO SAY WHAT RT WANTED

was watching a CNN report about Russian atrocities in Ukraine when the email arrived. It was from a producer for RT, the Russian government television network, asking to interview me about what she "the American called media's collusion with the Third Reich."

Why is Russian Television suddenly interested in how U.S. journalcovered Hitler? Evidently it has to do with


Vladimir Putin's bizarre references to Nazis in his attempts to justify the Russian invasion Ukraine.

According to Putin, the Ukrainians-including their Jewish president—are actually Nazis and therefore

the invasion constitutes "deNazification." RT, Putin's television network, promotes similar themes. On the day the RT producer's email arrived, the RT website featured articles claiming that the Ukrainian army is filled with "neo-Nazis", alledging that Russian citizens living in Ukraine are under attack from "neo-Nazi groups integrated into the government of Ukraine"; and asserting that the Biden administration is carrying "genocide" against Native Americans in Nevada.

RT.com also features wild accusations against the American news media, such as denouncing U.S. journalists for "vilifying" the January 6 rioters. Presum-

influential people. Zelensky was listed in the "leaders' category."

Jewish entertainers who made the list include Mila Kunis, who emigrated from Chernivtsi to the US at age 7, Andrew Garfield, Sarah Jessica Parker, Zoë Kravitz and Pete Davidson.

Talka Waititi, the Maori-Jewish director from New Zealand also known as Talka Cohen, made *Time*'s list. Waititi is perhaps best known for the black comedy film Jojo Rabbit (2019), the latter of which he also wrote and starred in as an imaginary version of Adolf Hitler. Jojo Rabbit received six Academy Award nominations and won for Best Adapted Screenplay.

Andy Jassy, CEO of Amazon, was named in the "titan's" category. Other Jews included photographer and opioid crisis activist Nan Goldin, who led protests in White Plains, New York against the proposed settlement in the bankruptcy trial of Purdue Pharma, and David Zasla, CEO and President of Warner Bros Discovery.

### Oldest Holocaust Survivor Dies

Boris Pahor spent time in Dachau, Mittlebau-Dora, Bergen-Belsen and Natzweiler-Struthof after being captured by the Nazis while fighting for the Slovene Partisans. He is best known for *Necropolis*, a 1967 autobiographical novel written after a visit to one of the Nazi camps where he had been held two decades earlier.

Pahor was born in Trieste which became part of Italy after the post World War 1 disintegration of the Austro-Hungarian empire. Slovenians were subjected to Mussolini's campaign of "Italianization" and Pahor soon realized that he was one of the "bugs" the Italian dictator wanted to crush. Pahor vowed loyalty to his Slovenian identity. He immediately joined the antifascist Slovenian resistance. His first arrest came in 1944.

"They started to beat me with leather straps - one on the right and one on the left - each with a whip, all over my body", Pahor said on a 2019 BBC documentary. "I was screaming. They didn't care. My back was like a zebra when I went back to the jail."

After the Holocaust Pahor stood for European and regional elections for the Slovene Union party, representing Italy's Slovene minority of about 80,000. He received Slovenia's highest award for cultural achievement after it broke away from Yugoslavia in 1991.

Pahor died at the age of 106. "With the passing of Boris Pahor, said Italian Culture Minister Dario Franceschini, "we have lost (Please turn to page 11)

ably such nonsense is a ham-handed attempt to undermine the credibility of media outlets that have been reporting about Russian atrocities in Ukraine.





The RT producer's claim that the U.S. media "colluded" with the Nazis in the 1930s is in line with the Putin regime's contention that the Ukrainians and their American supporters are all Nazis or Nazi-sympathizers.

It's a classic propaganda device—take the kernel of truth within a known historical episode, tear it out of its original context, and then twist and magnify it to suit some contemporary political purpose. Yes, many major U.S. newspapers downplayed or ignored news about the Holocaust--but that was poor journalism (and, in some cases, a kind of antisemitism), not "collusion with Nazism."

Such anti-American propaganda is a staple of RT. Originally known by its full name, "Russia Today," RT was created by the Putin regime in 2005. It is a propaganda agency, controlled and financed by the Russian government. Since 2017, its representatives in the United States have been required to register as foreign agents of the Russian government.

I wouldn't have known any of that from the producer's email, however. She described RT as an "international TV channel," with no clue as to its mission, financing, or governance. She never even used the word "Russia."

Obviously I have no interest in being used by Putin's television network for his propaganda purposes; I replied that I would agree to an interview only on condition that my full comments be broadcast, including my thoughts on how the lessons of the 1930s are relevant today. I explained that I would point out, among other things, that:

—Mainstream American newspapers in the 1930s

was an aggressive dictator who would threaten neighboring countries.

—The Russian public today is at a great disadvantage as compared to the American public during the Nazi era. The American press is genuinely free and independent, and so the U.S. public had access to sources of information about the Nazi persecutions even when the Roosevelt administration would have preferred that the public not know. Thus while the New York Times downplayed Holocaust news, other publications, such as the weekly New Republic and the New York City daily newspaper PM, highlighted it. By contrast, the Russian people today are unable to freely access information about Russian atrocities Ukraine because of the Putin

government's control of the Russian news media.

—The fact that American journalists 80 years ago did a poor job of covering the Holocaust is no reason to doubt the accuracy of today's American media coverage of Russian atrocities in Ukraine. Russia's war crimes have been amply documented by U.S. media outlets from across the political and ideological spectrum.

The RT producer's reply was not unexpected, but it was loaded with irony. "We are not interested in airing propaganda, nor including analysis which propaganda themselves," she said of my intended remarks. Pretty funny coming from a fulltime propagandist for the Putin regime! I guess I won't be hearing from RT again.

of Bat Yam, Sderot and Eilat. A large portion of the funds raised will be allotted to at-risk citizens, so that they have an easier time accessing mental health resources. "Through our investments in Israel which have had a life-changing impact. we contribute towards improving the quality of life for some of Israel's most vulnerable citizens" said McDonald. In addition, financial support will be provided for victims of terrorism and support for new immigrants, including those from the Ukraine.

## Orthodox Rabbi In A Church?

Jews, according to most Orthodox leaders, are not permitted to go into churches. A church is the site of *avodah zarah* or idol worship, something that is strictly forbidden under Jewish law.

But there was British Chief Rabbi Ephraim Mirvis in St. Paul's Cathedral in London for a prayer service honouring Queen Elizabeth's 70 year anniversary on the throne.

Well, it seems that the Chief Rabbi was simply following the guidelines of a 1970s ruling by the London Beth Din. That ruling allows rabbis to attend Christian religious ceremonies IF the rabbi's presence was requested by the monarch. And that was certainly was the case during the Jubilee celebrations.

The debate on this issue will not end with Rabbi Mirvis' presence. For some

a church is "more than just a building...it is a place where Christianity is palpable." But for more liberal rabbis the question is "why are you going to the church?" Entering a church, many Conservative and Reform leaders argue, does not necessarily mean worshipping.



### WHO BY FIRE; THE INCREDIBLE UNTOLD STORY OF LEONARD COHEN'S TOUR OF ISRAEL DURING THE YOM KIPPUR WAR

In October, 1973, the poet and singer Leonard Cohen – 39 years old, famous, unhappy, and at a creative dead end – traveled to the Sinai desert and inserted himself into the chaos and bloodshed of the Yom Kippur War. Moving around the front with a guitar and a pick-up team of local musicians, Cohen dived

headlong into the midst of a global crisis and met hundreds of fighting men and women at the worst moment of their lives. His audiences heard him knowing it might be the last thing they heard, and those who survived never forgot what they heard.

Cohen's war tour was an electric cultural

moment, one that still echoes today, and one that inspired some of his greatest songs - but a moment that only few knew about, until now. In Who By Fire, Canadian-Israeli journalist Matti Friedman gives us a riveting account of what happened during those weeks in Israel in October, 1973. opened 12 years ago and Chief Marketing Officer Phil Sabbah has been part of the operation since day one.

### Jewish Newspaper Turfed

The SAJewish Report has been expelled from the South African press council after it failed to publish a ruling on its front page which would have contained an apology to the South African BDS coalition for a story about its blatantly anti-Semitic cartoon. The coalition had initiated the complaint to the Press Council after the 2020 story appeared.

The cartoon depicted a fat greedy man shovelling money into his mouth. It was reminiscent of the tropes used by the Nazis in their war against the Jews.

Despite two prominent academics telling the council that the cartoon was anti-Semitic in nature,

the Press Council ruled against the SA Jewish Report. Chair Judge Phillip Levinsohn said that the decision was taken after "lengthy correspondence and

after the SA Jewish Report had refused to obey the rulings against it."

The SAJewish Report is the first publication in South African history

to be expelled from the press body.

Editor Peta Krost did not accuse the Press Council of being biased but she did maintain that the body was being used by the BDS coalition to further

their political aims. Added Krost: "As a newspaper for this community, we will continue to bring you the best possible news that's relevant our community...no matter what."

Meanwhile the BDS movement has hijacked a strike at the food and beverage company Clover, where workers have been on strike for months. Clover was acquired in 2019 by a consortium called Milco SA, which is led by the Israel Central Bottling Company. CBC is an Israeli-based manufacturer and distributor of soft drinks, dairy products, and alcoholic bever-

What should simply be a strike between management and workers has turned into an attack on Israel. Leon Louw, the president of the Free Market Foundation, told the SA Jewish Report that BDS had "successfully hijacked" a domestic labour matter to promote antisemitism. "BDS is abusing the workers and unions by injecting its anti-

semitic agenda where it has no relevance," he said. "The Jewish/Israeli connection is clearly irrelevant, and concocted to serve antisemitic agendas. The issue is entirely business economics."

## Feds Deliver On Commitment

In its April budget, the Liberal government confirmed that the Sarah and Chaim Neuberger Holocaust Education Centre in Toronto would receive \$2.5M as part of its commitment to the enhancement of Jewish life across the country. Marco Mendicino, minister of public safety, told a June news conference that "We need to keep alive the memory of those who senselessly lost their lives during the Holocaust. And it is imperative that we continue to combat historical distortions and denial related to its horrors."

Other commitments made by the government include \$20 million for the Montreal Holocaust Museum relocation and expansion; funds for the Vancouver Jewish Community Centre redevelopment project; \$85.6M over five years for the Office of the Special Envov Preserving on Holocaust Remembrance and Combating Antisemitism; and Amending the Criminal Code to prohibit the communication of statements that willfully promote antisemitism by condoning, denying, or downplaying the Holocaust.

## Expressing Gratitude to John Horgan

BC Premier John Hogan has sent a letter to the Jewish Community formally announcing his government's acceptance of the IHRA definition of antisemitism. as an important, nonlegally binding educational tool to help determine what is - and what is not - antisemitic. government, Horgan, "will be engaging with the Jewish community...and collaborating with you to address any identified rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism within government programs, policies and services." The BC government, the NDP premier stated emphatically, "stands with British Columbia's Jewish community in the fight against antisemitism as we always have and always will".

## Names and Events In the News

Ukrainian-born Jew and WhatsApp inventor Jan Koum flies under the radar but quietly has donated millions to Jewish causes...One of Great Britain's largest unions, the Gas Workers and General Labourers, unanimously passed a motion calling for antisemites. including those found guilty among its own membership, to "face the full force of the law."...Ukraine's chief rabbi,

Yaakov Dov Bleich, has denied sexual misconduct charges...A German court has ruled that St. Marien Church in Wittenberg does not have to remove the "Judensau" - Jew Sow sculpture from its facade. The court acknowledged that while the content of the carving was offensive it ruled that the chuch had taken sufficient steps to counter this by installing a memorial and information board. The verdict can still be appealed to Germany's constitutional court.
