Reflection on Passover

Stripped of the nostalgic warmth of the memories which it evokes, the ultimate significance of the Pesach festival is its position as the primal Jewish Festival of Freedom. Jews may date their history as a people from Abraham, the Father. But this history actually begins with Moses, the Liberator and the Lawgiver. It is the memory of their sojourn in Egypt as slaves under the Pharaohs which marks the beginning of their consciousness of themselves as a people, with its own unique role to play in the development of civilization. It is the escape from this slavery into freedom which has been the lodestar which has led the Jews through subsequent centuries. And it is the memory of this escape which has given them strength in their struggle to preserve their faith and their dignity during those sanguinary centuries during which they endured the bitter and bloody fury of medieval mobs, spurred on by theologians who saw Jews as deicides, worthy objects of persecution and condemned by their rejection of the Christian saviour to torture and death.

The modern Jew, even those who today live in relative comfort, has not escaped the traumatic effects of the experiences of our forefathers. The agonizing death of those who perished in the auto-de-fe's of Spain, in the massacres of the Crusades, in the repeated sackings of the ghettos of Europe, in the savage pogroms of the Chmielnicki era, in the ultimate horror of the gas chambers and crematoria of Auschwitz, have left scars upon us deeper than we perhaps know. Future generations will add October 7 to the seemingly never ending list of those who have sought vengeance simply because of our religious beliefs.

If Jews are inclined to be insular, mistrusting the non-Jewish world about them, if we are not entirely free of the fear of again having to suffer the stinging lash of the non Jewish whip, there is ample reason for it. Conversely, if we are somewhat more compassionate that we might otherwise have been, if we may be counted among the "social revolutionaries" who are most deeply involved in the burdens of persecution and deprivation others bear, surely it all begins with the collective memory of our slavery in Egypt and our experiences as a people over the past millenia.

Yet the Festival of Passover, despite our difficult journey and the current wave of antisemitism, provides a glimmer of hope. For in the inspiring story of our redemption is implicit the promise that deliverance will come today as it came to our forefathers millenia ago, that there is justification for the hope that in the darkness of the present is the promise of light for the generations to follow.



COLOURING BOOK FOR FUTURE TERRORISTS

ARAB BOOKSTORE SEEKS TO INDOCTRINATE CHILDREN

The Israeli police recently arrested the proprietors of an Arab bookstore in Jerusalem that was selling books promoting hatred of Jews and glamorizing terrorists. One was a coloring book, a fact that prompted much mockery on social media. Big, strong Israel is afraid of a little children's book!

The book is called From the River to the Sea, an old Palestinian Arab slogan calling for replacement of Israel with an Arab state of Palestine. Intended for six to ten year-olds, the book features color-by-number pages that demonize Israel and honor terrorists and terror-supporters.

There's Ghassan Kanafani, senior official of the terrorist Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine, best known for its airplane hijackings in the 1970s, its murder of an Israeli cabinet minister in 2001, and its massacre of rabbis in a Jerusalem synagogue in 2014,

There's Refaat Alareer, the "poet" who called the October 7 attack "legitimate and moral," denied the

Hamas gang rapes, and joked on social media about whether baking powder was used in burning Israeli babies to death. In the coloring book, Alareer is flanked by a large flaming kite, the kind Hamas has used to torch countless acres of Israeli farmland.

There's Ahed Tamimi, the teenager who rose to fame when she was arrested for assaulting Israelis, and then later arrested again for writing on social media following October 7: "Come on settlers, we'll slaughter you. What Hitler did to you was a joke. We'll drink your blood and eat your skulls."

The coloring book also features a page devoted to the Intifadas, the waves of mass Palestinian Arab violence in which more than

THE BIBAS DENIERS

A NEW TYPE OF DENIER HAS EMERGED AFTER OCTOBER 7TH

There are Holocaust-deniers, who claim that accounts of the Nazi genocide are all a hoax. There are October 7 deniers, who say that Hamas did not commit any atrocities during its 2023 invasion. Now it seems that a new type of denier is emerging—the Bibas deniers.

Killers and their cheerleaders hope to obscure their crimes in a mass of impersonal statistics. It's hard for the public to identify with millions of victims. But focusing on one or two individuals, with names and faces, dramatizes their suffering in a real and imme-

diate way. That's why the story of Anne Frank is so compelling. And that's why the murders of four year-old Ariel Bibas and his nine month-old brother, Kfir, by Palestinian Arab terrorists has become such a problem for Israel's enemies.

"Anne Frank's baby brothers," as the human rights scholar Thane Rosenbaum has aptly described them, are no longer part of an anonymous body count. The brutal murder of the two little boys in Gaza has come to symbolize the horrors of October 7 the same way the story of the young girl hiding in an attic in Amsterdam has come symbolize the Holocaust.

Haters of Israel understand that publicizing the truth about the Bibas murders generates sympathy for Israel and undermines the Palestinian Arab cause. That's why they are trying to deny, or at least minimize, the Bibas killings,

The denial campaign is being led by Hamas itself—at least in its state-

ments to the outside world. Hamas spokesman claim the boys were killed in an Israeli air strike. Israeli forensic experts who examined the children's bodies found that in fact they were murdered with the terrorists' bare hands. Afterwards the bodies were mutilated in a transparent attempt to disguise what had been done.

Who to believe? On the one hand, there are medical professionals who were trained in respected educational institutions. On the other hand, there is an international terrorist group



The CCR aims to help the OU, and beyond, to better understand and serve Jewish community through both qualitative and quantitative data. In the winter of 2023, the CCR team, together with Dr. Moshe Krakowski, Director of Doctoral Studies at the Azrieli Graduate School of Jewish Education, conducted the first of a twopart study, and collected qualitative data via interviews with 29 "religious switchers" — 15 women and 14 men, ages 18 to 43, who left Orthodoxy. Participants






HONOURING JEWISH ATHLETES












terpretations of Iran's objectives, it directly cites Iran's own constitution to demonstrate its goal of imposing Islamic rule over all of humanity. It underscores why dismantling Iran's nuclear program is not enough—the regime itself must be removed.

While the recent defeat of Iran's proxies Hamas, Hezbollah, and Assad's Syria has brought a sense of relief to many, especially in Israel, it is premature to celebrate.

Iran's goals have not faded simply because of the demise of its proxies. The

threat the Islamic Republic continues to pose to all humanity lies in plain sight in its foundational document, its constitution.

Adopted in 1979 and amended in 1989, the Constitution of the Islamic Republic is a clear articulation of a future world order that Iran believes it is destined to impose, first on the Islamic world, and then on

that calls the Holocaust a hoax and claims The Protocols of the Elders of Zion is genuine. The Protocols is actually quoted in the Hamas charter, a fact which illustrates Hamas's fealty to the truth.

For the emerging class of Bibas Deniers, the truth doesn't matter. All that matters is how to absolve the killers and harm Israel.

The French politician and European Parliament member Rina Hassan tweeted that the Bibas children actually were killed by the Israelis. She reiterated that claim in a radio interview, in which she added that "Hamas has a legitimate cause."

Omar Dajani, a law professor at the University of the Pacific, in California, recently retweeted a message asserting it is "unclear" whether Israel or Hamas killed the Bibas children.

That's like saying it is "unclear" whether the Nazis killed Jews, or they died from other causes.

Another way to help Hamas escape responsibility is the "everybody does it" approach. Zaid Tyam, who is stationed in The Hague as the representative of Fatah, the Palestinian Authority's ruling faction, said on Egyptian television's last week that Israel is in no position to accuse Hamas of abusing hostages such as the Bibas children, because Israel itself has "abused" the families of imprisoned terrorists by not releasing them sooner.

Meanwhile, Whoopi Goldberg, co-host of ABC Television's The View, disrupted comments by one of her colleagues about the Bibas children. Goldberg asserted that while many people say "Hamas is the bad guy," that is not the (Please turn to following page)

Others have different ways of trying to distract attention from the Bibas children. At the University of Michigan, students painted a large boulder in orange with the names of Ariel, Kfir, and their mother, Shiri. vandals Pro-Hamas promptly used spray paint to cover their names with the words "Free Palestine" and Hamas symbols.


Ironically, many average Gazans are not de-

nying the Bibas murders they've been celebrating them. Hamas held a public ceremony in the town of Khan Yunis, at which the Bibas children's little coffins were displayed, just before they were handed over to Israel (in exchange for the release of killers of other Israeli children). Large, joyous crowds gathered at the scene. Families relaxed on lawn chairs, played music and sang songs. Sweets were distributed, hookah pipes were puffed. Fathers lifted their children for a better view of the coffins, in a scene eerily reminiscent of the crowds that cheered the lynchings of African-Americans in the old South.

Like other Holocaust deniers, the Bibas deniers come in different varieties but they are all part of the same team: the killers, the cheerleaders, the deniers, the minimizers-they all share the same agenda: they aim to inflict pain on all the Jews.

The appropriate way to deal with the Bibas deniers is the same way decent people deal with Holocaust deniers: ostracize them. The Constitution protects their right to engage in hate speech. But it does not obligate anybody to offer them platforms on which they can express their hatred of Jews.

"The phenomenon of attrition from the ranks of Orthodoxy raises many questions about the extent which our families, schools, and communities are succeeding in meeting [the] goals [of assuring] Jewish identity, engagecontinuity," ment. and writes OU Executive Vice President Rabbi Moshe Hauer, in the study's foreword.

"These questions," he adds, "are essential to the work of every one of the OU's programmatic departments, all of which focus on enhancing the current religious experience of Jews and supporting the education and engagement of the next generation. They are also the questions that preoccupy parents, educators, and communal leaders seeking to understand our successes and failures."

Rabbi Hauer expressed gratitude on behalf of the OU to the study's participants, whose insights, he hopes, will raise communal awareness.

Although an indepth qualitative study of this kind cannot demonstrate how common any factor that impacts religious trajectories may be, Dr. Krakowski notes that the interviews do allow us to see the mechanics of leaving in a way that a more superficial survey would likely miss.

"Our deep dive into these participants' lives allows us to build a range of 'models' of leaving, unpacking their disparate experiences to better understand those experiences shape their lives," he says. "This gives us something called 'analytic generalizability' - a way to gain a conceptual understanding of the phenomenon of leaving Orthodoxy that can be applied to a wide variety of contexts and cases."

Dr. Krakowski adds, "For example, most of our participants began questioning Orthodoxy before completing high school — some as early as middle school. Because we understand how and why this was the case in our subjects' lives, we can identify other people and other contexts where it makes sense to assume early questioning is present."

Among the concerns participants frequently raised were their perception of Orthodoxy's insularity, rigidity, and intolerance, concerns about feminism and Orthodoxy, and the consequences meted out for



social and religious deviations.

"I will never forget the conversation I had with my mother," one participant shared. "I said to her, 'I don't think you have to have a beard and wear a white shirt to be a good person.' I asked her, 'If I would come to your house wearing jeans, would you still love me?' She said 'No."

Many participants experienced conflicting parental beliefs or rapid religious changes during their childhood. Dr. Krakowski explains, "One parent might have been charedi, while the other didn't keep Shabbos, or parents changed their religious orientation quickly, leaving other members of the family scrambling to keep up. For example, a family might

barely keep kosher one day and keep Chalav Yisrael the next."

Dr. Krakowsi adds, "These types of religious misalignment, which are not just on a more-or less-religious scale, but also on a differently-religious scale, destabilize and create dissonance for people, leading them to explore other types of religious possibilities and ways of living."

Participants largely felt different from their peers socially, religiously, or financially, leading to a sense of exclusion. Many switched communities or schools, which either contributed to, or exacerbated, their sense of isolation.

One participant recalled the community's response when her children



switched schools: "We ended up putting our kids in public school, and that completely changed how the community responded to us, connected with us... people wouldn't let their children play with ours. People were not inclusive... [they] stopped saying good Shabbos...they didn't want to socialize with us."

Dr. Krakowski notes that although he didn't ask about religious authority figures, almost all participants touched upon experiences with religious leaders that significantly impacted their connection to Orthodoxy.

"They spoke about both uplifting and deeply negative experiences, primarily with rabbis, but also with female religious leaders, which had a lasting effect on them," he says.

Negative experiences included rabbis who bullied, belittled, or excluded them due to perceived deviance. Some participants also cited unethical or inappropriate behavior from rabbis, which often intensified their negative views of

Orthodoxy. Some rabbis were dismissive or reluctant to address participants' religious inquiries.

One of the study's main takeaways for rabbis and educators is the imperative to identify those who are questioning as far in advance as possible.

"Questioning starts early," says CCR Principal Researcher Dr. Rachel Ginsberg. "Waiting until the end of high school to evaluate whether students are connecting is too late. Listening, validating concerns, and offering space for exploration is critical."

The findings suggest supporting families with religious misalignments, especially Ba'alei Teshuva and converts, may also prevent attrition. As for how these families may be supported, Ginsberg notes that the study is the first step in a broader communal conversation. One of the primary goals of the study is to provide data that can inform our understanding of why individuals leave the Orthodox community", she





(Continued from page 8) says. "Sharing this critical information with the Jewish community and shining a light on the issues that need addressing is a critical step in advancing communal solutions. The data points us in the right direction, but it does not leave us with concrete, detailed solutions; for that, we look to the entire Jewish community to partner with us to develop innoand effective vative, programming and support

Despite its sobering findings, the study also reveals promising news: of the 29 participants, some returned to Orthodox observance and many maintain strong ties with Orthodox family members, friends, Jewish traditions, and texts despite leaving Orthodoxy. Some continue to keep Shabbos, daven, and attend Orthodox shuls. Others wish for their children to pursue an Orthodox lifestyle, should they be inclined, and some even send their children to Orthodox schools.

"The fact that many who leave the Orthodox community still feel connected to Orthodoxy is an important insight," says Dr. Ginsberg. "It has the potential to reshape the way we

engage in discourse around this topic. Talking about attrition in a much more inclusive and sensitive way could keep people closer, as opposed to pushing them further away."

The study recommends that Orthodox institutions, like shuls and schools, adopt a more inclusive mindset and foster tolerance for others' differences, welcoming those who leave and keeping the door open for their return.

Rabbi Hauer emphasizes that the question the Orthodox community

must address is: What are we prepared to do differently?

"If we truly want to make meaningful, positive change regarding American Orthodox Jewish attrition, our community will need to pursue the data that will inform that change and commit to act based on what we find," he says. "All of us will do well to read this report, study it, and take a long and honest look in the mirror."

all humanity. The preamble is unequivocal that the raison d'etre of the Islamic Republic is global, to assure "the development of man in accordance with the noble and universal values of Islam." Iran believes it has the divine mandate to be the agent for the fundamental reordering of the world and all its people under Islam.

Imposing Shia philosophy

The constitution explains that its first target is the Muslim world. Article 11 cites the Quran: "This your community is a single community, and I am your Lord so worship Me" (21:92), and then explains that it means Iran's role is to impose the "political, economic, and cultural unity of the Islamic world." For Iran, this "unity" means forcing its Shia ideology on the Sunni Muslim population, which constitutes 85-90% of the Islamic world.

However, the regime's aspirations don't stop there. Its fundamental goal is to impose Islamic law





on every human being on the face of the earth: "The Constitution will strive with other Islamic and popular movements to prepare the way for the formation of a single world community."

Whereas attempting to spread Islam via education or diplomacy could be legitimate, Iran assigns imposing Islam to its military. The preamble: "The Army of the Islamic Republic of Iran and the Islamic Revolutionary Guards Corps... will be responsible not only for guarding and preserving the frontiers of the country but also for fulfilling the ideological mission of jihad in God's way; that is, extending the sovereignty of God's law throughout the world."

For Iran's faithdriven regime, the collapse of its proxies and the resurgence of Sunni power in Syria will never change its mission, but that has created the need for a change in strategy. Iran can no longer depend on slowly expanding its sphere of influence. Fulfilling its mission of world subjugation now depends on possessing overwhelming force - the kind that can be achieved only through weapons of mass destruction.

Even before the defeat of its proxies, Iran was behind in its timetable. The constitution expressed with assurance: "[T]his [20th] century will witness the establishment of a universal holy [Islamic] government and the downfall of all others." Iran understands that possession of weapons of mass destruction as the means to impose Islam is now even more urgent.

Tragically, the West has failed to recognize that it has been at war with Iran for decades. This was made clear again immediately after Israel delivered a crippling blow to Iran's air defenses.

Instead of that being the trigger for it to follow up and destroy Iran's nuclear program, the West, led by the US, pressured Israel to be satisfied with the great but limited achievement.

Hopefully, the Trump administration will recognize the dangers and seize the unique opportunity to reverse this policy.

However, even destroying the nuclear program will not change Iran's fundamental goals pressed in its constitution, nor the threat it presents to humanity. Weapons of mass destruction today come in various guises, including biological, chemical, and radiological, and the Islamic regime would pay any price to acquire them and for other proxies to deploy them. Blackmailing humanity with the choice of submission to "God's law throughout the world," or

facing mass casualty events would become the foreign policy of Iran, should it ever possess a weapon of mass destruction. Iran will cease to be a threat only after the tyranny of a minority of Islamists is replaced by the rule of the majority in a free and democratic Iran.

Preventing Iran from obtaining nuclear weapons followed by dismantling the regime are both urgent priorities, for the Iranian people and the free world. Both objectives are achievable.

Significantly, unlike other countries where the toppling of one dictator has resulted in the liberated people choosing another worse tyrant, the Persian people prior to the Islamic Revolution had a record of moderation and even had good relations with Israel. A liberated Iranian people today would immediately dissolve the Islamist constitution and seek harmony with their neighbors and the world, thus removing the greatest threat humanity

faces.

Since weapons of mass destruction are now coming in smaller packaging, and Iran's defenses have not yet been rebuilt, there will never be a better time to impose regime change and to send Iran's constitution and dreams of world subjugation into the dustbin of history.

TWO MEN CONVICTED OF MURDER FOR HIRE PLOT TARGETING IRANIAN ACTIVIST



IN A HUSHED MANHATTAN FEDERAL COURT, Iranian-American journalist and human rights activist Masih Alinejad relived the moment she came face-to-face with an alleged hit man. Khalid Mehdiyev had been recruited by two Azerbaijan nationals, Rafat Amirov and Polad Omarov, to assassinate Alinejad on behalf of foreign interests hostile to her activism. Alinejad has long lived a life in jeopardy since fleeing Iran in 2009. Mehdiyev said he is cooperating with prosecutors but faces a minimum of 15 years in prison for the attempt on Alinejad's life and separate racketeering charges. He pleaded not guilty to murder-for-hire charges in February 2023, but the status of his case is unclear. Prison records show he was released from U.S. custody on May 19, 2023

1/2 tsp sea salt

1/2 tbsp cinnamon (you can add in other warming spices like ginger and numeg)

1 tbsp flax seed

1/4 cup coconut oil

1/3 cup + 1 tbsp agave syrup (maple or honey work well too)

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 medium ripe banana, mashed (~1/2 cup)

Instructions

Preheat the Oven: Set your oven to 350°F (175°C).

Prepare the Dry Ingredients: In a large mixing bowl, combine the matzah, cinnamon, sugar, salt, flaxseed, and nuts. Stir well to evenly distribute the ingredients.

Make the Wet Mixture: In a small saucepan over medium-low heat, warm the coconut oil, maple

syrup (or agave/honey), and vanilla extract. Stir occasionally until fully melted and combined.

Incorporate the Banana Puree: Remove the saucepan from heat and whisk in the banana puree until smooth and well blended.

Combine Wet and Dry Ingredients: Pour the warm liquid mixture over the dry ingredients in the bowl. Stir to ensure everything is evenly coated.

Spread and Bake: Evenly spread the mixture onto one or two baking sheets, making sure it's not overcrowded to allow for even crisping.

Bake to Perfection: Place in the oven and bake for 23-28 minutes, or until golden brown. Keep an eye on it, as the coconut oil helps it crisp up but can cause it to brown quickly.

one thousand Israelis were murdered and thousands more were injured and maimed.

The text accompanying the coloring pages teaches children that Israel has no right to exist, since it is "a military outpost of Western imperialism" that "was created on the land of Palestine"; that Israel is an evil, oppressive, genocidal monster; and that those who give their lives for the Palestinian Arab cause are "martyrs—heroes who have a special place in Palestinian society."

The book's author, Nathi Ngubane, explained in recent interviews and a Tiktok promotional video that he wants to inspire children to action. He hopes "to educate them and let them know that they can also join the fight for freedom...It is important for children to get to the truth as much as possible in order to lend a hand of solidarity."

From the River to the Sea fits in perfectly with the books that the Palestinian Authority and Hamas have been using for decades to educate Palestinian Arab children.

The PA textbook Mathematics, Vol. 1 teaches addition to third graders by counting the number of "martyrs" and the number of "prisoners in the Occupation prisons." Fifth graders study from Arabic Language, Vol. 2, which extols the "hero" Dalal Mughrabi, leader of the Coastal Road massacre of 37 Israelis. "We are proud of them, sing their praise, learn the history of their lives, name our children after them, and name streets, squares, and prominent cultural sites after them," the book says of Mughrabi and her comrades.

Eighth graders learn from Arabic Text and Reader that they need "to exterminate the Zionist germ and thrust this evil out of the Arab homeland" and that "the time has come for jihad and martyrdom" against "the oppressor." In ninth grade, Islamic Education, Vol. 1 explains how Allah offers believers opportunities for "fighting against infidels" to "honor them by martyrdom, to forgive their sins and raise their class in Paradise."

In General Sciences for tenth graders, Newton's laws of physics are explained through the example of "a young girl using a slingshot towards a specific target," with a photo of an Arab child whipping a rock with a homemade sling. The calculation uses variations in the length of the sling and

the rock's release speed to determine its rate of acceleration.

In the twelfth grade, Islamic Education teaches "the virtue of jihad in Islam," especially "if the enemy occupied a Muslim land." It stresses the importance of jihad both as "one of the gates to achieving martyrdom" and as Allah's way to achieve "rescue from (Please turn to page 34)

The fire of Hell and the attainment of pardon and Paradise."

When this schoolhouse incitement was first documented by Palestinian Media Watch, back in 2007, then-U.S. Senator Hillary Clinton alarmed. "These textbooks do not give Palestinian children an education; they give them an indoctrination," she said at a press conference. Palestinian Arab children are "encouraged to see martyrdom and armed struggle and the murder of innocent people as ideals to strive for." The PA "profoundly poisons the minds of these children. . . It is a clear example of child abuse."

Evoking the themes in her book It Takes a Village, about the communal

influences that shape children's lives, Sen. Clinton warned that Palestinian and Arab hate education would have "dire consequences for prospects of peace for generations to come." She was right. Sixteen years later, some of the children raised on these teachings carried out the October 7 atrocities.

Israelis are justifiably concerned about the impact of the From the River to the Sea coloring book, just as the Allied authorities in postwar Japan would not have tolerated a coloring book praising the attack on Pearl Harbor, and the authorities in postwar Germany would not have allowed bookstores to sell a coloring book extolling the glories of Nazism. Raising children to be bigots and terrorists is a recipe for catastrophe, as October 7 so horrifically demonstrated.
